

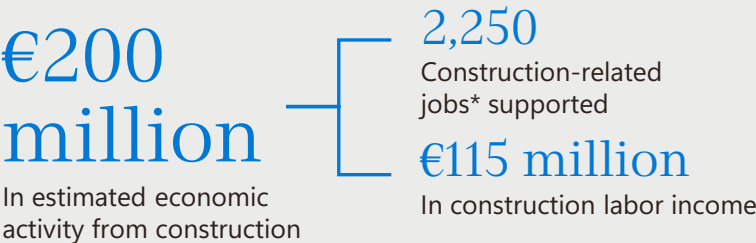
Microsoft's datacenter economic impact in Finland



Microsoft is making significant long-term investments in datacenters across southern Finland. This infographic summarizes the estimated economic impact of those investments, including job creation, labor income, community investments, and broader economic activity. In 2022, we announced the locations/region across municipalities in Espoo, Vihti, and Kirkkonummi.

Operational impact in 2025



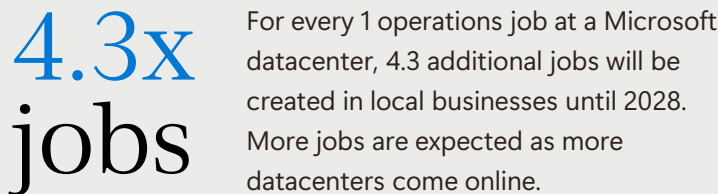
The current operational workforce reflects an early-stage site. Additional employment will grow as development continues, including expanded Microsoft roles, contractors, and broader economic activity, with projected impacts outlined on page 2.

*Construction-related jobs include direct on-site construction labor, indirect jobs within regional supply chains, and induced jobs supported by household spending.

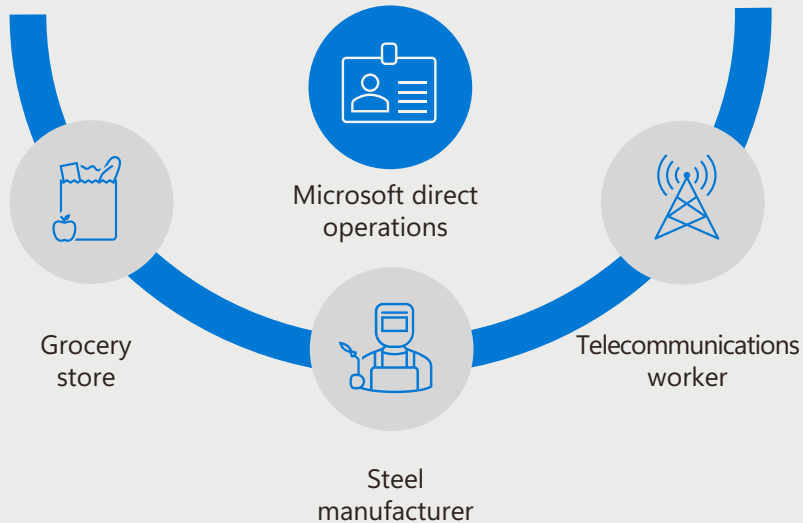
**Local jobs include direct Microsoft datacenter employees, indirect supplier and service-provider jobs, and induced jobs supported when workers spend wages locally.
